





New bursaries support thriving communities

We are excited to share the news that the Province of Nova Scotia has partnered with How We Thrive to create a bursary fund that opens the door to 50 people who couldn't otherwise attend the upcoming How We Thrive learning event (June 2-5, MSVU). Please forward this announcement to those in your network who would be keen to take advantage of this opportunity.

The bursaries reduce the fee to \$30 and will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- You live in Nova Scotia.
- You work or volunteer for a small non-profit or social enterprise OR you are applying as an individual (e.g., community volunteer, student).
- You want to connect and learn with others who are passionate about their communities and engaged in making a difference.
- You have read through the Thrive home page and 2019 website and feel this gathering is right for you.
- You are able to take part in the full four days.
- You need the bursary in order to attend.

The deadline is May 3rd, and successful applicants will be notified by May 10th.
